Visit the ranch where President Lyndon B. Johnson hosted world leaders and made important decisions during the 1960s.

#### **4. PIONEER MUSEUM**

Immerse yourself in the stories of the German settlers who built Fredericksburg.

#### 7. LUCKENBACH TEXAS

Made famous by Willie Nelson and Waylon Jennings, this is a place to relax under oak trees and listen to the best tunes in Texas.

#### 8. TEXAS WINE COUNTRY


Sip on award-winning vino from over 75 wineries, vineyards and tasting rooms in Fredericksburg and Gillespie County.

# HERITAGE LAYERED IN limestone

ere, history is all around you. In the soil, limestone buildings and lingering German accents, Fredericksburg is a representation of all who've come before. As you venture into Gillespie County, hugged by its rolling hills, you'll find an overwhelming friendly feeling. A spirit that founded this town nearly two centuries ago—commemorated by a life-size bronze statue at the heart of town, Marktplatz.

It's a friendliness that has weathered wars, with historic sites like Fort Martin Scott, the first U.S. military post to be established on Texas' western frontier.

Fredericksburg's is a history of passion and pride—generations of families carrying on legacies and preserving the town's rich heritage in dialects, structures, artifacts and continued traditions. From its foundation in 1846, the 120 German settlers who called this slice of Hill Country "home," Fredericksburg has blossomed into a community of entrepreneurs, artists, makers and more.

Wherever you venture, however you roam, you'll find this generational warmth at every turn. A stroll along Main Street is a stroll through time, with glimpses, snippets and snapshots of the past preserved in the limestone architecture, shared stories and cherished photographs.

To dive deeper, live like an early settler at Pioneer Museum for an "in-town" experience—featuring original buildings, complete with a home, blacksmith shop, one-room schoolhouse and Sunday House. Or venture out and experience a working 1900s farmstead, the Sauer-Beckmann Living History Farm. Located in Stonewall, the Sauer-Beckmann Farm offers year-round immersion, with period-specific interpreters tending to the animals, garden and property for a once-in-a-lifetime tour through the past.

While in town, visit the ranch and former home of the 36th President, Lyndon B. Johnson (the Texas White House is currently closed for renovation). A 1960s time capsule, his home features a "hotline" to Washington from his dining room table, vintage car collection and airplane lovingly referred to as "Air Force One-Half."

From pioneers to presidents, a respect for the past is imbued in everything we do.







Kids can get a taste of chores in the 1800s at the Pioneer Museum Complex.

See a real working early 1900s farmstead at the Sauer-Beckmann Living History Farm at Lyndon B. Johnson State Park and Historic Site.

Back in town and right in the heart of the historic district is a must-do even for non-history buffs. The National Museum of the Pacific War—including the Admiral Nimitz Gallery, named after Fredericksburg native, Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz—is a state-of-the-art facility and Smithsonian Affiliate that pays homage to a war never to be forgotten.

Historically speaking, there's so much to see. Visit St. Mary's Catholic Churches, built in 1861 and 1908. Check out the Sunday Houses sprinkled throughout town (many now guesthouses) that stand as a reminder of our past. Pick up a walking map of our nationally recognized historic district at the Visitor Information Center or explore the Gillespie County Country School Driving Trail.

#### MUSEUMS AND HISTORIC SITES

The Albert Dancehall was built in 1922 by Max Beckman, and provided the community a place for Saturday night dances and social gatherings. It featured German brass bands rotating between the Luckenbach, Hye and Weinheimer dancehalls of the time. Located just south of Highway 290, halfway between Fredericksburg and Johnson City, the tradition of community gatherings and dancing continues.

#### **10 4** CEMETERIES

Fredericksburg has two main historic cemeteries located at the east and west ends of town. Der Stadt Friedhof, located at the 300 block of N. Lee St., and the Catholic Cemetery, located on Catholic Cemetery Road, are both known for their striking granite markers and headstones, many in German.

#### **2** CHRISTIAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH

Built in 1887 and formerly called "The Colored Methodist Episcopal Church," this simple white frame structure, with its small steeple, sits atop a native limestone foundation and has been renovated in recent years.

#### © CROSS MOUNTAIN PARK

On North Milam just at the outskirts of town. Cross Mountain is located on a historic marl and limestone hill with an elevation of 1,951 ft. featuring beautiful views, walking trails, butterfly garden and picnic areas. It was used as an Indian lookout prior to early settlers. In 1847 during the settling of Fredericksburg, a timber cross was found on the hilltop, and early Fredericksburg pioneers gave this hill the name "Kreuzberg," or Cross Mountain. In 1946, a permanent lighted cross was raised, and a new cross was erected in 2024. Enjoy a walk to the top for the scenic overview.

#### **®** FORT MARTIN SCOTT HISTORIC SITE

Take a self-guided walk at the site of a pre-Civil War (1848) military outpost, designated as a Texas Historical Commission site, to learn about one of the first frontier Army forts in Texas. A nature trail begins on the north side of the fort and winds for about half a mile along Barons Creek, where you can see wildlife and wildflowers.

Hours: Grounds open daily from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Buildings open Thu-Sat: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. No admission charge.

## GILLESPIE COUNTY COUNTRY SCHOOLS DRIVING TRAIL

View 17 historic country schools in Gillespie County. A special map with highlighted routes will direct visitors to schools in a particular quadrant of the county. The National Park Service operates the LBJ Ranch and offers public access to the ranch, Texas White House (currently closed for renovation), LBJ's birthplace, Johnson family cemetery, old Junction School, LBJ's grandparents' home and ranch show barn. Hours: LBJ State Park Visitor Center (for driving permits):

Open daily from 8:30~a.m. to 4:00~p.m.

Ranch Exit Gate: Closes at 5:00 p.m.

Closed: Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day. Admission: Free. Visitors must obtain a free driving permit at the LBJ State Park and Historic Site Visitor Center in Stonewall, TX. Permits are valid only for the day of issue.

#### Johnson City District:

Located in Johnson City, this National Historical Park offers a Visitor Center with exhibits and films on LBJ and Lady Bird, the Boyhood Home, an education building and the historic Johnson Sottlement

Hours: Visitor Center and Boyhood Home 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily; Johnson Settlement sunrise to sunset daily.

No admission fee at Johnson City District.

#### NATIONAL HISTORIC DISTRICT

Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, the area has more than 80 points of historic significance and interest. Stroll past many of Fredericksburg's famous structures and see the pride taken in both homes and businesses by the local residents. Free self-guided walking tour maps of the district are available at the Visitor Information Center at 302 E. Austin St.

From hiking, biking and volkssporting to stargazing and sightseeing, the rolling hills of Gillespie County are filled with adventures, memories and cherished traditions waiting to be discovered.

#### BICYCLING

The back roads of Gillespie County provide miles of scenic views for road bicycle riding. Although the area roads are lightly traveled compared to big cities, riders are encouraged to obey all rules of the road to ensure their safety. With the hilly terrain, cars can come upon bicyclists without much notice, so please stay as far to the right as possible. Mountain biking enthusiasts will enjoy Hill Country State Natural Area, near Bandera, and Pedernales Falls State Park, near Johnson City. See bicycle rentals, page 39.

#### BIRDING

Approximately 300 species of birds can be found in the Texas Hill Country, where birding is great all year. The area is an overlap zone of ranges of eastern and western bird species, as well as some northern and southern species. Be sure to look for the endangered Black-capped Vireos and Golden-cheeked Warblers. An excellent place to view birds in Fredericksburg proper is the Live Oak Wilderness Nature Trail at Lady Bird Johnson Municipal Park on S. State Hwy. 16. Stop for a bird checklist at the park office. Pedernales Falls State Park, near Johnson City, has wildlife viewing stations, while Enchanted Rock State Natural Area, 18 miles north of Fredericksburg, is also a premier birdwatching location.

#### **FISHING**

Fishing opportunities are available in Hill Country state parks and at area lakes. The closest place for kids to drop a line in the water is Lady Bird Johnson Municipal Park. Tres Molinos Ranch & Resort in Harper, TX, (830) 992-8783, offers a stocked pond along with bait and tackle. See city and state parks, page 12.

#### HUNTING

The Fredericksburg area of the Texas Hill Country is home to many native and exotic species of animals, which allow sportsmen almost year-round hunting opportunities. White-tail deer are the most popular and plentiful quarry pursued by hunters, but there are also turkey, doves and quail. Many ranches in the Hill Country now manage their herds to improve the quality and health of the animals. In addition to the native game, exotics such as axis deer, blackbuck antelope, fallow deer, sika deer and feral hogs are abundant.

#### **ROCK CLIMBING**

Estimated to be over one billion years old, the pink granite domes and boulders of Enchanted Rock State Natural Area make it one of the best climbing venues in all of Texas. See more information at tpwd.texas.gov/state-parks/enchanted-rock.

The first volkssport (German walking sport) event in the United States was held in Fredericksburg in June 1976, and the Volkssport-verein Friedrichsburg (club AVA-001) was the first club organized in the U.S. The club sponsors three year-round walking routes, which start at the Sunday House Inn & Suites, located at 501 E. Main St.

Old Tunnel State Park features an abandoned railroad tunnel that was built in 1913. The tunnel is now home to a colony of approximately 3 million Mexican free-tailed bats. These bats migrate up from Mexico and are present in the tunnel from May through October each year. Visitors can come out and view the bat emergence from the upper viewing area any night of the week during bat season for a \$2 per person fee. The lower viewing area is only open on Thu-Sun evenings for a \$5 per person fee, which also includes a formal interpretive program.

Due to the bats' sensitivity to noise, children age three and under are not allowed at the lower viewing area. State Parks and Bluebonnet passes are not accepted for this activity tour fee. Permits for both viewing areas can only be purchased online through the reservation system. No permits will be sold at the park. The park is open from sunrise until 5 p.m. - no entrance fee or permit required. After 5 p.m., all visitors must have a bat viewing tour permit. It is recommended for those with permits to arrive at least one hour before the earliest posted emergence time. Please check the Old Tunnel State Park Facebook page for current emergence times and additional information.
